

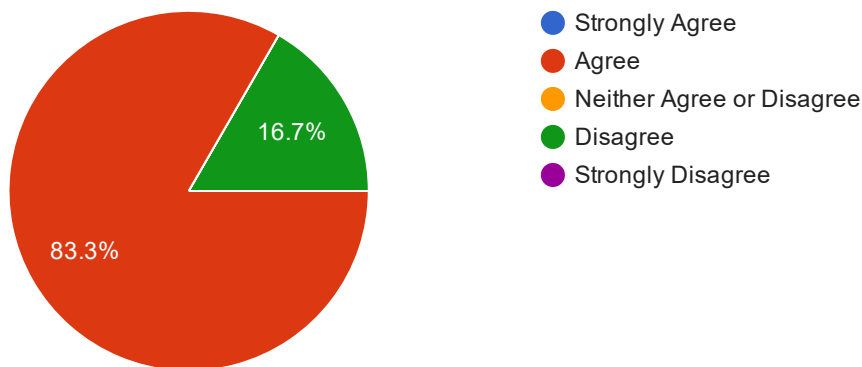

Shared Commitment

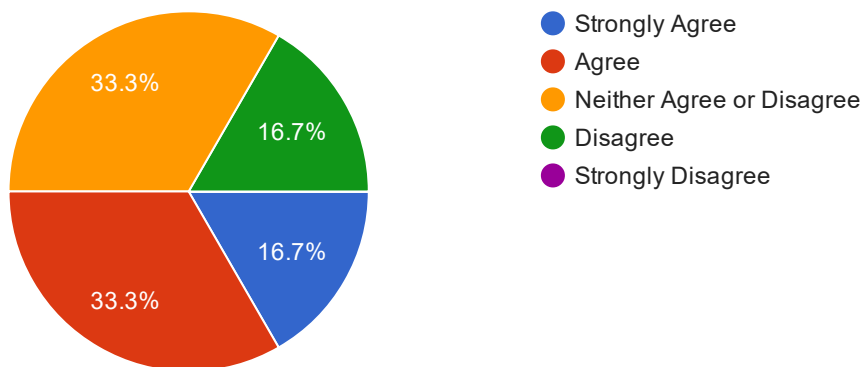
There is agreement and a shared understanding on the objectives of the Rugby Local Strategic Partnership.

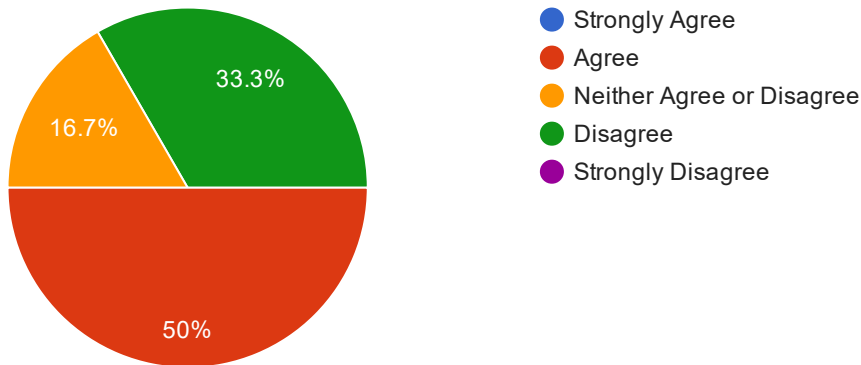
Feels as if the LSP needs to become more dynamic - with less resources available, it is difficult to keep momentum and pace.

Partners take responsibility for their contribution to the Regeneration Strategy Action Plan.

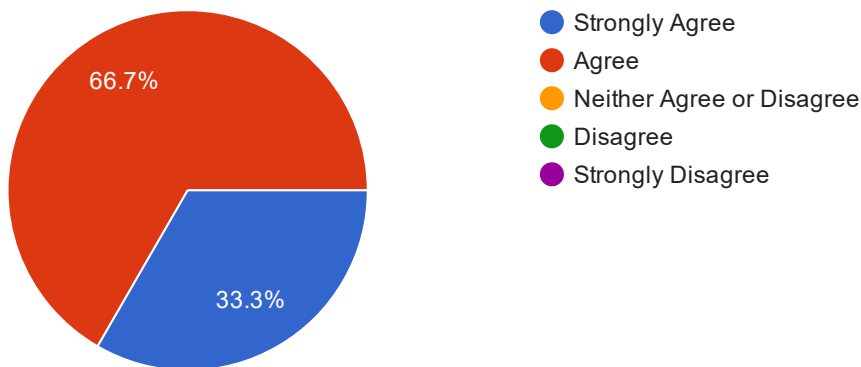

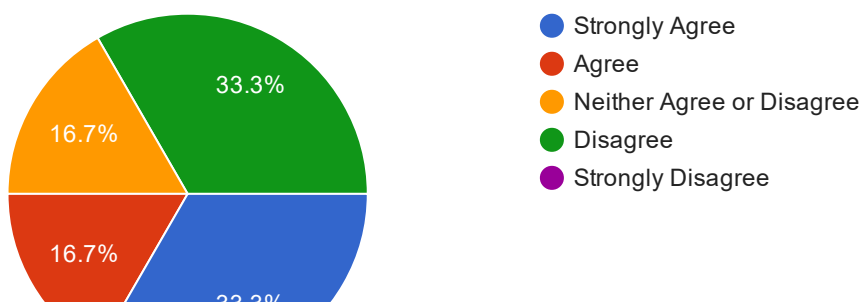
Partners have the right relationships, shared values and behaviours to work together for the public good.

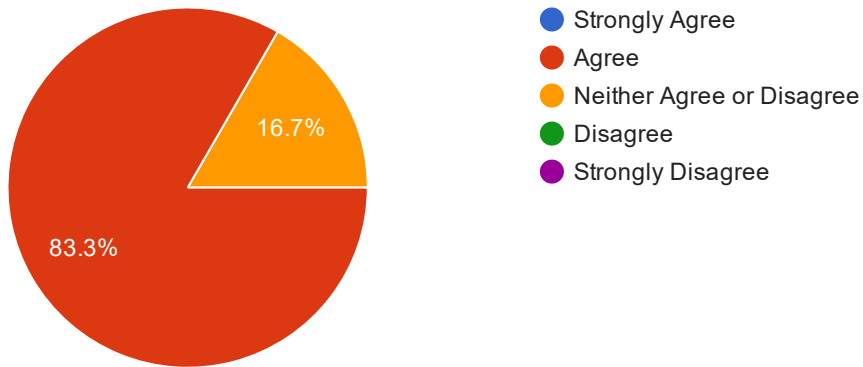


Partners have honest conversations about the challenges facing the Local Strategic Partnership and its component parts.

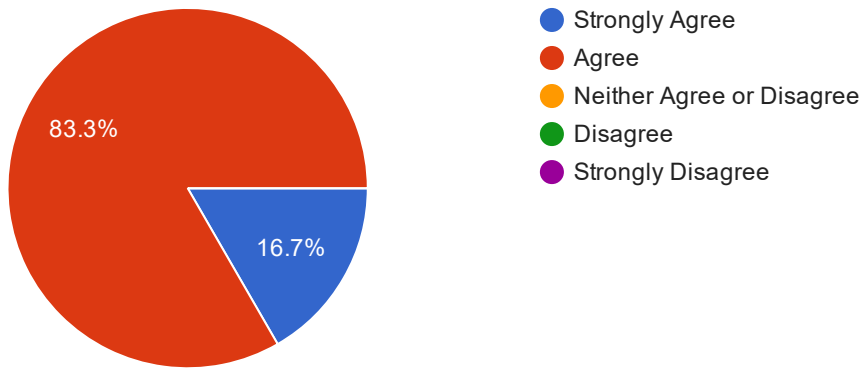


Partners are able to reach shared solutions (6 responses)

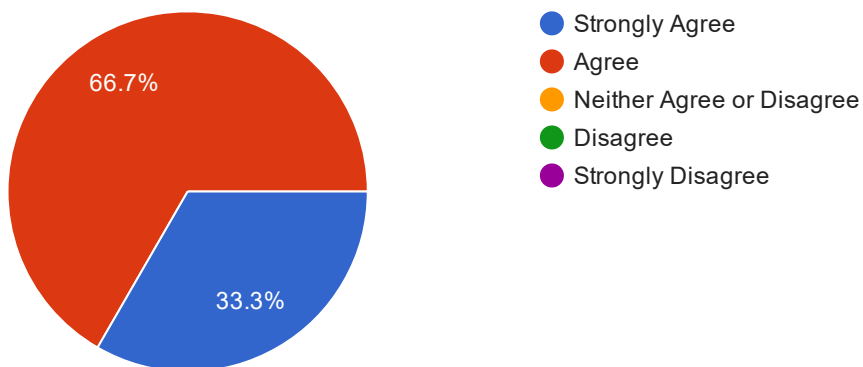


There is a willingness to put the needs of the public before the needs of individual partners.

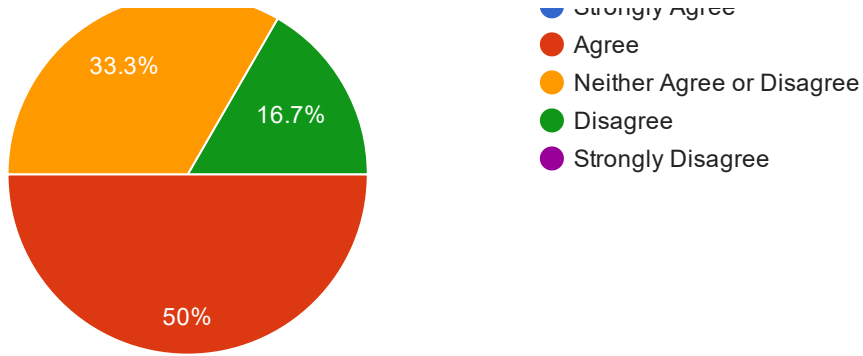


There is trust between partners. (6 responses)

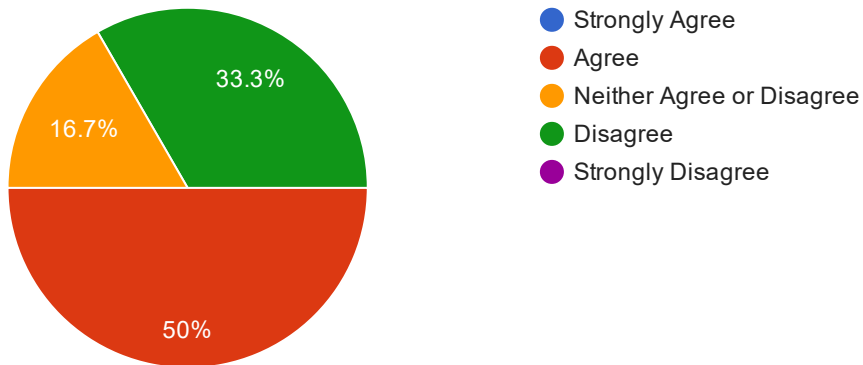


Shared accountability and commitment to getting the job done

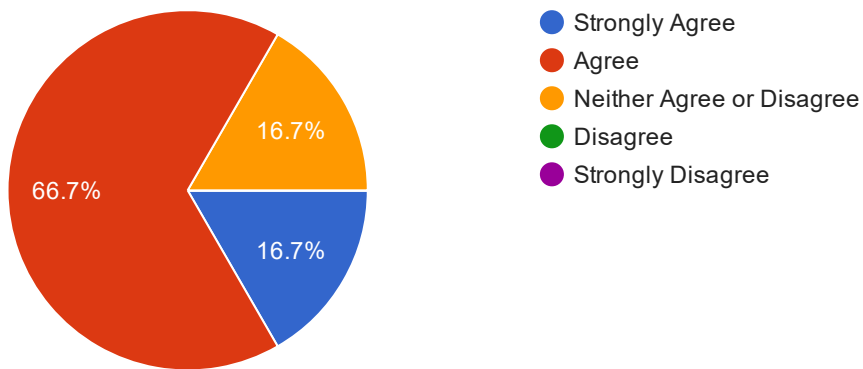
The roles and responsibilities of partners are clear. (6 responses)

Partners share information well. (6 responses)

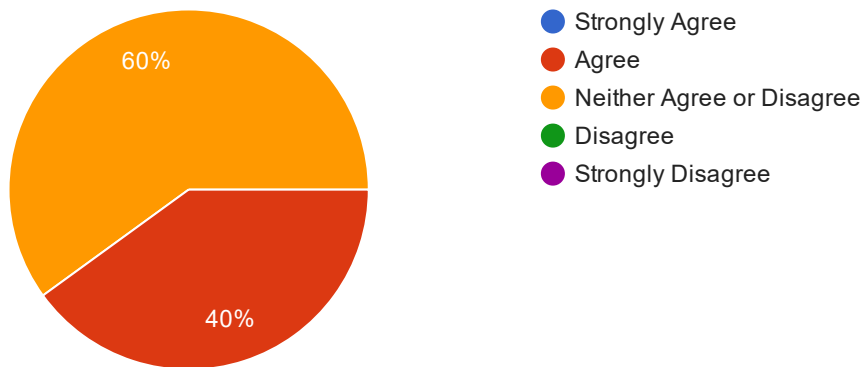


There is open communication between partners. (5 responses)



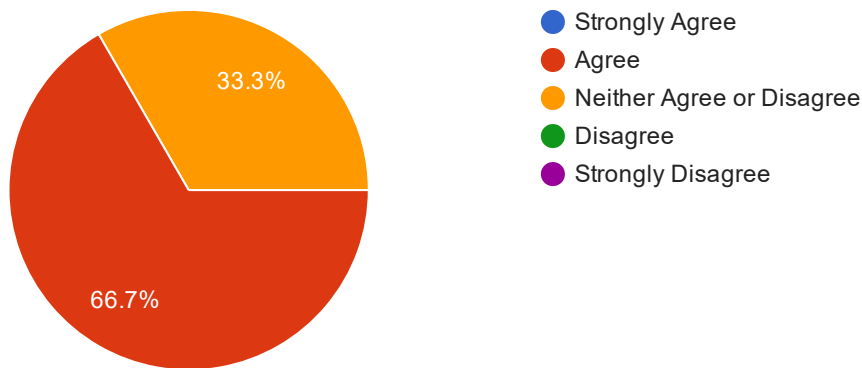
The right information is provided to the right people to enable them to carry out their roles and responsibilities.

Partners cannot be held to account for actions if they no longer hands on deliver services. They can only facilitate and influence.

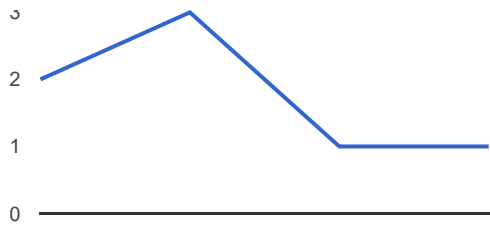
I feel it has the potential to be more effective than it currently is. The willingness to improve is there but we need to focus even more on actual delivery of the action plan.

I think it would be very beneficial if the planning of new GP premises could be linked to a formula for increased housing as with education. New developments were planned by NHS England, but as CRCCG has become level three co-commissioning the CCG will be more involved. As this will operate at a more local level it would be good if there was a formula for calculating local needs, a strategic meeting with the council and NHS England and the CCG (which I think there is) and then local meetings with the council and GPs who may be in need of larger premises. I know the council is keen to help.
